

This is an attempt – made by a non specialist and completely based on the existing literature – to collect in a single document information about the German colours in use during WWII. Each page is devoted to a RLM color. FS stands for FS595 and HU is the Humbrol equivalent. A few notes on the usage are given, based on the sources listed below. I hope that this document will be useful for anyone interested in this topic.
